THE WRIGHT BROTHERS MASTER PILOT AWARD



- The Wright Brother's "Master Pilot" Award is the most prestigious award the FAA issues to pilots certified under Title 14 of the Code of Federal Regulations (14 CFR) part 61.
- This award is named after the Wright brothers, the first US pilots, to recognize individuals who have exhibited professionalism, skill, and aviation expertise for at least 50 years while piloting aircraft".


ELIGIBILITY FOR THE WRIGHT BROTHERS MASTER PILOT AWARD

- 1)Have 50 years of U.S. piloting experience. The effective start date for the award is the date of the applicant's first solo flight or military equivalent.
- 2)Have held a U.S. Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) or FAA pilot certificate with: •50 or more years of civil flying experience, or •50 or more years of civil and military flying experience, of which up to 20 years may be U.S. military experience.

- The award may be presented to a nominee up to 3 years posthumously if the nominee has acquired 50 years of U.S. piloting experience prior to passing away.
- Nominations will take a minimum of 60 days to be accepted
